

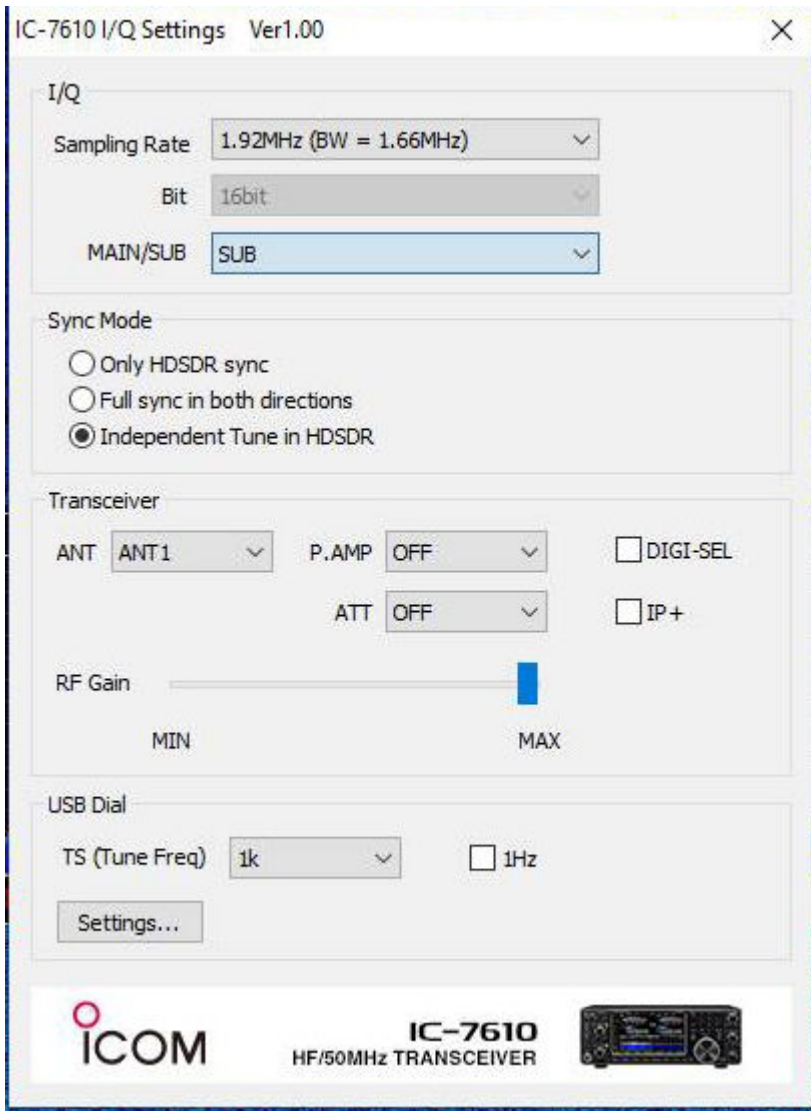
Icom 7610 HSDSDR as a 3rd Receiver

HSDSDR as a 3rd Receiver Settings

In HSDSDR if you followed my previous article there are only two settings to check/change. Those are in the EXtIO settings, the MAIN/SUB and Sync Mode. Have a look at the video below to see how it works.

In this video we look at using the Icom 7610 with HSDR and using HSDR as a 3rd receiver.

Things to Look For

- When tuning in HSDR use the mouse to point and click. Using the scroll wheel on the mouse changes both the Lo and the Tune frequency.
- You will be limited to the same band between HSDR and the IC-7610. The other receiver (in the video the MAIN) can be tuned to a different band.
- Audio from HSDR is sent to your PC speakers. Note the change in audio quality in the video when I unmute HSDR.
